Meet Conditions:

- Age as at day of the meet, 7th August 2010.
- This meet will be conducted under SNZ rules and the local conditions listed.
- No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
- Entries **\$6 per individual event**
- Late entries (**\$12.00 per event**) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane.
- Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply
- NO TIME entries will not be accepted. No time trials permitted.
- Swimmers are required to meet the qualifying standard of at least one ASA Level 2 event.
- Swimmers may enter either the 400 IM or the 400 Free, but not both.
- 800 freestyle entries must achieve the ASA Level 2 qualifying time for this event.
- All events will be timed finals, with results declared for males and females in the following age groups: 10/under, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over.
- Reseeding or combining of heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- Sponsors' or Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall place getters, male & female in each age group.
- Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers per session to a max of 4 unless requested for more before the meet. Please supply names with entries.**
